












DMTN-155: Interim Model for Community Support

- Data Management is not scoped to provide community support in construction.
- Nevertheless, DM staff have been doing an excellent job of providing ad-hoc support to the community. As we move into pre-operations and demand for support grows, a scalable and sustainable model for continued support is required.
- Operations addresses this need with the Community Engagement Team (CET) led by Melissa Graham, which is tasked to support the entire Rubin scientific community.
- The CET is ramping up now in pre-operations and are building "A model for community engagement and user support for science with the Rubin Observatory", <u>RTN-006</u>, which includes the Discourse platform adopted for <u>community.lsst.org</u>.

- The CET is ready to take the lead on forum design and evolution into operations.
 - following established protocol of proposing changes in the Meta category for open discussion
 - nearly done epic <u>PREOPS-189</u> "Deliver an evolved Community Forum" for DP0
 - \circ ~ but future evolution in the design and functionality will continue to be assessed
- The CET is not scoped for technical maintenance or upgrades.
 - will this be Data Production?
- DM/DP participation in "Support" channel is awesome and essential.
 - if there are ways the CET can better support DM/DP's participation, let's hear it
 - Project/DM-specific categories, groups, etc. to continue; welcome to propose design upgrades to CET
- Administrators: accounts have the power to edit all forum functionality
 - currently Jonathan, Frossie, and Melissa
- Moderators: can deal with flagged posts, move posts, silence users, and more
 - limited to Rubin Observatory staff; currently all CET members and some DM/DP staff
