### **Issues**

None created, 2 resolved. Notably the initial incident with NFS mounts to PDAC crashing (IHS-571)

### Discussion of Notable Issues

On 01/Nov/17, Igor Gaponenko reported that the NFS-mounted (GPFS native) file systems were hanging. Initial diagnosis pointed to one GPFS server going down. While there was redundancy and GPFS failed over, NFS did not.

Over the course of the next week, NCSA systems, storage groups and vendor support (IBM & Lenovo) performed troubleshooting and mitigations to try to stabilize the service. The service continued to crash intermittently however.

On Nov. 10, escalated to D&M. Resulting meeting included Michelle B, Igor, Fritzit & NCSA. It was proposed that NFS are seemed to be the likely root cause of the problem. Igor noted that the failures did not correlate with the load his processes imposed on the system. An additional fact was that Igor's transfers was not a majority of the load on NFS. Because no problems appeared with GPFS testing, it was agreed to mitigate the problem by supplying only native GPFS mounts at the earliest opportunity if SLAC indicated this to Michelle B. On Nov 14, these changes went live as of 11/14, no problems have been seen. The original incident was closed, GPFS was supplied under a new issue (IHS-xxxx) to provide early lifetime support. Igor has been informed and understands that he will open a new issue if he has further problems.

IHS-603 (Emergency change): GPFS has been installed on qserv nodes allowing Igor's ingest to proceed. Ticket will be closed when early lifetime support is closed.

IHS-601: Completed. Directory stucture and appropriate permissions set to support Merlin's processing of prototype auxTel data

IHS-597: Provide support (firewall rule modifications) for file transfers to UW. Such services are already provided to partners at IN2P3, SLAC, and UC Davis. Approved by security, passed on to systems engineering for implementation.
