This will permit the CCB to decide if an RFC introducing a new package can be approved or not</li> <li>DMCCB agreed to board recommend RFC-720</li> <li><a href="#">John Swinbank</a> asked if we should check if the env change breaks the external user code <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><a href="#">Tim Jenness</a> no, people usually pick a weekly and stick to it for months</li> <li><a href="#">Colin Slater</a> this is acceptable if it happens not so often</li> <li><a href="#">Tim Jenness</a> due to the use of conda-forge, we can't do puctual updates</li> <li><a href="#">Kian-Tat Lim</a> the idea is to move the environment in a conda metapackage, and this probably makes possible to pin back some package in the the environemtn</li> <li><a href="#">Wii O'Mullane</a> CCB needs to be aware that somebody may be affected when other packages changes</li> </ul> </li> <li>RFC-719, is not under the radar of the DMCCB</li> <li>RFC-718 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>this requires a new Jenkins job</li> </ul> </li> <li>RFC-712, KT to look at it</li> <li>RFC-703 to move end date to Aug30</li> </ul>
