		<ul> <li>Dick: what is position of tools that are useful for looking at results?</li> <li>Frossie: prefer not to bundle ds9; hard to keep in sync with upstream</li> <li>RHL: do use ds9 in a fairly integrated fashion, but not tenable in the long run</li> <li>Frossie: should have agnostic interface with drivers/adapters</li> <li>RHL: SCAMP is probably not good enough, though</li> <li>Either help you install it or just point to Web site</li> <li>Xiuqin: also prefer not to bundle, since will be replacing eventually; not hard for users to great pick: many packages might fall into this category of "useful with stack but not required" <ul> <li>Want policy for future, but not really a big issue right now; documentation already say</li> <li>Better error messages might help</li> </ul> </li> <li>Recommendation: packages for optional features that are tightly integrated and expected packages even if tightly integrated that are not expected to remain so should not be distributed.</li> </ul>	vs to download yourself to remain so should be distributed;
